NOTICE OF EMPLOYEE TRANSFER

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. §§ 358.1 and 284 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's regulations (as may be further revised from time to time, the "Standards of Conduct"), the Standards of Conduct apply to any interstate natural gas pipeline that transports gas for others and conducts transmission transactions with an affiliate that engages in marketing functions.

Pursuant to Section 358.7(f)(2) of the Standards of Conduct, a transmission provider must post a notice on its internet website of any transfer of a transmission function employee to a position as a marketing function employee, or any transfer of a marketing function employee to a position as a transmission function employee.

Effective June 17, 2024, Teresa Murray transferred from a position as a shared services employee (i.e., Manager Contract Admin) to a position as a transmission functioning employee (Senior Manager Scheduling). Prior to Ms. Murray's role as Manager Contract Admin, Ms. Murray held a position as a marketing functioning employee (i.e., Manager Gas Scheduling). Though the Standards of Conduct do not require notice of a transfer from a shared services employee to a position as a transmission functioning employee, given Ms. Murray's previous role as a marketing functioning employee, Sabine is making this posting out of an abundance of caution.
